Site Inspection Note

The under signed inspected the project site, along with CIDCO representative on 28/03/2018. A total of 22.549 Ha. of forest area (Reserved Forests, Protected forest and Deemed Reserved Forests) has been proposed under diversion for the purpose of public utility infrastructure on the forest land in respect of rehabilitation of people displaced due to upcoming Navi Mumbai International Airport at Pushpaknagar, Tal. Panvel, District Raigad.

The undersigned visited the proposed forest land at village Dapoli. The project proponent has demarcated and categorized the proposed diversion area into six patches. The boundary pillars were numbered and their GPS location were shown on the maps. The actual GPS location of randomly selected pillars were taken and cross verified at patch no.1, 3 and 4. The readings were found to match with those shown on the map. During inspection it came to notice that the adjoining non diverted forest area at patch no. 1, 2,3 and 4 is vulnerable to encroachments and hence it is essential to do compound wall fencing along the entire stretch after proper survey and demarcation. Besides there are two forest patches comprising parts of survey no. 124 and 128 that are not part of diversion proposal. These are in the form of two green islets, landlocked by non forest area and highly prone to encroachments. Hence they need to be clearly demarcated and protected through construction of compound wall.

Barring patch no. 1 and 2 most of the area is devoid of tree growth. The user agency proposed public utility infrastructure in the forest area under diversion.

Work has not been started on forest land, and no violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 was noticed.

PROJECT NOTE

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General Manager (Environment and Forests) CIDCO, CIDCO Bhavan, CBD-Belapur, Navi Mumbai submitted a proposal for area 22.549 ha. for public utility infrastructure to the Rehabilitation of PAPs of Navi Mumbai International Airport at Pushpaknag, Village Dapoli, Taluka Alibag.

The project authority previously submitted a proposal for diversion of forest land for rehabilitation of PAP's of Navi Mumbai International Airport which is submitted to the Govt. of India for approval by proper channel. In the FAC meeting held on 12/7/2016, it wad denied approval in the present from. The same was conveyed by Asstt. Inspector General of Forests, MOEF & CC vide letter No. FC-II/MH-16/2015/NGP, dtd. 8th August, 2016.

The project authority re-plans the area excluding the rehabilitation of the people on the forest land. As per revise plan prepared by the project authority the public utility infrastructure is proposed on forest area and submit this proposal for the diversion of 22.549 ha. forest area.

The user agency has not started any work on proposed forest land.

This project involves 25.5490 ha. forest land, therefore the compensatory non-forest land is required. Hence, the project proponent is offered non-forest land in village Karivane S.No. 21/2 area 12.500 ha. and at village Temghar S.No. 57/1 area 10.049 ha. (total 22.5490 ha.) of Taluka Roha in Roha Forest division. The project authority is willing to bear the cost of compensatory afforestation and all Government levies as required by the Government.

This project is part of Navi Mumbai International Airport project which is essential for infrastructure development and is of national interest; hence the proposal is being recommended for approval for diverting the required forest land
