Sub: Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 – Proposal for diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road through Kattur RF to a length of 700m in Kancheepuram Forest Division in Chengalpattu District in favour of the Divisional Engineer, Highways, Nabard and Rural Roads, Chengalpattu - Proposal forwarding off - Regarding.

I wish to state that in the reference 1st cited, the Divisional Engineer, Highways Department, Rural Roads, Chengalpattu has uploaded online forest clearance proposal under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road through Kattur RF to a length of 700m in Kancheepuram Forest Division in Chengalpattu District under proposal No. FP/TN/Road/148726/2021.

- 1) Brief details of the project are given below.

i) The User Agency has uploaded the proposal in the prescribed format of Form A - Part I - under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of fresh forest area.

ii) In the short narrative of the proposal for which forest land is required reported as relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road km 0/910-1/610.

iii) Diversion of 0.49 ha of forest has been requested in Kancheepuram Forest Division area in Chenagalpattu District. Name of the village reported as Mailai Rayamangalam for 0.49 ha forest area and component wise break up reported as road.

iv) Location map of the forest land proposed to be diverted in kml file of google earth, Scanned copy of Survey of India topo sheet indicating the boundary of forest land proposed to be diverted, Scanned copy of Geo referenced location map has been furnished.

v) The user agency has proposed forest area diversion for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road (km 0/910-1/6190) for 700m length with 3.75m carriage way and shoulder width of 1.625 m on either side in the Kattur RF.

vi) The user agency has stated that the project or part thereof is not located in any protected area or their Eco sensitive zone.

vii) The User Agency has furnished the certificate issued by the District Collector, Chengalpattu District about completion of process for settlement of rights under Forest Rights Act, 2006 on the forest land proposed for diversion in Ref. No. B2/1192/2021, dated 06.09.2021

viii) The user agency has furnished certificates/ undertakings/ details under additional Information details section.

a) Certified that, there is no work in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 has been carried out in the project area.

b) Certified that forest land requested is the minimum required for the project and all other alternatives have been examined and found not feasible.

c) Undertaking to pay the Net Present Value of forest land required for the project.

d) To bear the cost of raising and maintenance of compensatory afforestation and or penal compensatory afforestation as well as cost of protection of plantation

as per the scheme prepared by the Government of Tamil Nadu in lieu of RF land diverted for the project and to deposit additional amount if any suggested as amended owing to change in planting technique, enhancement in FSR etc.,

e) Undertaking to pay the cost along with any escalation for exploitation of trees if any available in the alignment path.

f) Undertaking to lay the lease rent as fixed by the Forest Department at the time of sanction along with any escalation for the subsequent years.

g) Certificate obtained from the District Collector, Kallakuruchi about non-availability of non-forest land for the project in Ref. No. B2/1192/2021, dated 06.09.2021

h) Area requirement for the project reported as 700m length and 3.75m width for carriageway and 1.625m width on either side for shoulder thus area requirements is 0.49 ha

2) The District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division has forwarded the proposal along with Site Inspection report and recommendation of the proposal to the Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle on 07.03.2022 and furnished EDS reply on 22.03.2022 and 21.03.2022.

In the Part-II of Form A the District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division has furnished following details.

i) The legal status of the proposed site of diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land requested for the project is Reserved Forests.

As per the site inspection report and recommendation of the project uploaded by the District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division, name of the forest land reported as Kattur RF.

ii) Density of the forest area is Zero and Eco class of forest area is four.

iii) Species wise and girth class wise enumeration of trees in the area is reported as NIL.

iv) Vulnerability of the forest area to erosion reported as NIL

v) The District Forest Officer has reported that Spotted deer, Peacock, Rabbit etc., are present in and around the forest land proposed for diversion. The forest area proposed for diversion is not part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor, Wildlife migration corridor etc., and not located within the eco-sensitive zone of the protected area notified under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and not located within 1 km boundary of

NP/WLs etc., for the forest land proposed for diversion. There is no rare/ endangered / unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.

vi) There is no protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

vii) Requirement of forest land as proposed by the User Agency is unavoidable and bare minimum for the project and no work in violation of the Act or guidelines has been carried out.

viii) Forest area proposed for diversion is 0.49 ha and there is no felling of trees involved.

For the proposed diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land in Kattur RF for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road, compensatory afforestation has been proposed in 0.98 ha of degraded forest area of Kattur RF by planting of 980 number of misc seedlings along with maintenance of plantation over a period of 10 year period at a cost of Rs. 19,29,829/- including 5% amount provided to contingency fund to meet out the special nature of works for restocking the plantation and furnished the cost estimate of the CA scheme and area marked in the Survey of India topo sheet and surveyed sketch of the proposed CA area in geo-referenced map. Site suitability certificate of the CA area has also been furnished by the District Forest Officer.

ix) In the site inspection report, the District Forest Officer has stated that, site inspection carried out on 04.03.2022. Total area required for diversion is 700m length and 3.75m width for carriage way and 1.625m width on either side of the road for shoulder (total width is 7.00m)

a) The District Forest Officer has reported that, on inspection, it was found that the road was already laid long time back in forest area and there is no proper records available on when the road was formed by the user agency. Also, the requested forest stretch is in continuation of the already existing Mailai-Rayamangalam road. As per the report of the user agency, the present road was constructed before 1985 and it was maintained by Rural Development Department and also informed that the last renewal was carried out prior to 2009 and the road is heavily damaged for the past 12 years in forest portion. Forest Range Officer, Tiruporur reported that this road has right of way.

b) Now the Divisional Engineer (H) N&RR, Chengalpattu has applied for diversion of 0.49 ha of this forest land for relaying and periodical maintenance of

the road. There is no tree growth along the existing road in the forest area proposed for diversion. The road is highly essential for providing access for the people of surrounding villages.

c) Many representations from all corners were received by the District Administration and the District Collector, Chengalpattu has also insisted during the inter departmental meeting for the upkeep of this road and ambulances are facing problem crossing the particular road stretch passing through the Kattur RF due to the bad condition of the road in this stretch.

d) Taking into consideration of the above facts, the proposed diversion of 0.49 ha area in Kattur RF has been recommended by the District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division.

3) The Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle has inspected the area on 30.03.2022 and endorsed the details provided by the District Forest Officer and recommended the proposal. Forest clearance proposal forwarded through web portal on 08.04.2022.

4) The User Agency has requested forest area diversion for a period of 99 years. The District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division and the Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle have recommended the diversion of forest area for a period of 20 years.

Based on the recommendations made by the District Forest Officer and Conservator of Forests, diversion of forest land is recommended for 20 years.

5) State Government may accord diversion of forest land of less than one hectare in each case for non forestry purposes under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for creation of critical development and security related infrastructure of Government Departments under the general approval of Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 guidelines. Construction and widening of road is one of the work allowed under general approval list.

6) In the Part-II of Form-A, the District Forest Officer has reported that no work in violation of the Act or guidelines issued under the Act has been carried out.

However in the site inspection and recommendation of the project proposal, it has been reported that on inspection, it was found that the road was already laid long time back in forest area and there is no proper records available on when the road was formed by the user agency. Also, the requested forest stretch is in continuation of the already existing Mailai-Rayamangalam road. As per the report

of the user agency, the present road was constructed before 1985 and it was maintained by Rural Development Department and also informed that the last renewal was carried out prior to 2009 and the road is heavily damaged for the past 12 years in forest portion. Forest Range Officer, Tiruporur reported that this road has right of way. However, details on right of way available for the proposed road of relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam has not been reported.

However the existing road of carriageway width 3.75m width road relaying and periodical maintenance of road with shoulder width of 1.625m on either side - total road portion in forest area of 7.00m has been proposed for diversion.

7) Based on the recommendation made by the District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram Division and Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle, proposal received for diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road through Kattur RF to a length of 700m in Kancheepuram Forest Division in Chengalpattu District seeking approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 by the Divisional Engineer, Highways, Nabard and Rural Roads, Chengalpattu is recommended for consideration of the Government subject to the following conditions.

- a) The legal status of the diverted forest land remains unchanged.
- b) The demarcation of the proposed forest land shall be carried out by the User Agency by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at their cost.
- c) The user agency has to pay the cost towards compensatory afforestation scheme over an extent of 0.98 ha of degraded forest area as per the Compensatory afforestation scheme including maintenance for a period of 10 years.
- d) The User Agency has to pay the Net Present Value of proposed forests diversion area which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India /Government of India.
- e) The User Agency has to bear the additional amount of Net Present Value which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as fixed by Forest Department in future. The user agency has to furnish undertaking to this effect.

f) Amount of Compensatory afforestation scheme, Net Present Value of diverted forest area under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)

g) The User Agency has to pay the cost towards annual lease rent for the forest area diversion period as fixed by the Forest Department at the time of sanction along with any escalation for the forest land to be diverted of the above project in future for the entire project period.

h) The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceeds 0.49 ha for with a width of 700 m and width of 7.00m (3.75m carriage way and 1.625 ha shoulder on either side) in Kattur RF.


i) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under any circumstances be transferred to any other agencies/department or person without prior approval.

j) Period of lease can be twenty (20) years. The User Agency has to apply renewal proposal before one year of expiry of lease with the State Forest Department.


8) The proposal is sent herewith duly recommended by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation Act) / Nodal Officer of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 of the State of Tamil Nadu. I request that the proposal may be considered and approval may be issued for diversion of 0.49 ha of forest land for relaying and periodical maintenance of Mailai-Rayamangalam road through Kattur RF to a length of 700m in Kancheepuram Forest Division in Chengalpattu District in favour of the Divisional Engineer, Highways, Nabard and Rural Roads, Chengalpattu for a period of 20 years.
