

Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Giridih East Forest Division

On 13th Dec 2023, the undersigned inspected the deemed forest areas (Jungle-Jhari Land) and notified forest land in following villages proposed for diversion for construction of 132 KV DC Jamua-Gawan Transmission Line. Details is as below: -

The crop density of deemed forest and notified forest area for this linear diversion proposal is approx 0.2. There are standing trees of Acacia, Babool, Bael, Bahera, Ber, Bhelwa, Dumar, Gamhar, Eucaliptus, Imli, Jackfruit, Jamun, Kahua, Karam, Karanj, Kend, Khair, Kusum, Mahua, Aam, Mahanimb, Palash, Pipal, Sal, Salai, Sisam, Sidha, Semal, Siris, Neem etc. The proposed area measuring 46.287 ha. is moderately vulnerable to soil erosion. No rare, endangered or unique species of flora and fauna are found in the proposed diversion area. No any protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monuments is located in proposed diversion areas.

Moreover, the proposed site was inspected physically and found to be diverted as there is no feasible alternatives possible for laying of transmission line.
