

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA-1980)

A proposal has been received by this office from **Executive Engineer CD-2 PWD Hamirpur** diversion (under FCA-1980) of 49.32ha. Of protected forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of protected forest land for 4-Laning and Strengthening of Bilraya-Panwari Road(SH21) From Ch..399.600 to 427.00, in District:Hamirpur

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated -27-08-2019.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 49.32ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
