

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, SHAMSHABAD
DIVISION IN SHAMSHABAD AND MANKHAL RANGES ON 25.07.2020
FOR LAY OF OPTICAL FIBER CABLE

I have inspected the proposed area for Lay of Optical Fiber Cable along the road side within the existing right of way passing through Jalpally RF, Tumaloor RF, Srinagar RF and Masjidgadda RF falling in the Shamshabad and Mankhal Ranges. The Forest Range Officer, Mankhal and also incharge of Shamshabad Range on 25.07.2020. The concerned Forest Section Officers and Forest Beat Officers are followed during the inspections.

The proposed diversion of forest land is situated along the road side which is in Compt. Nos. 347 of Jalpally RF Shamshabad Range of Shamshabad Division. The proposed Optical Fiber line for diversion in length of 471.11 mtrs and width of 0.40 mts passing through Jalpally RF. Further, it is proposed that, the Optical Fiber Cable is also passing through Tumaloor RF, Srinagar RF and Masjidgadda Reserve Forest blocks of Mankhal Range.

the details of the length, width and area Reserve Forests proposed in Mankhal Range are as follows;

1. Tumaloor RF block compt No. 331, Tumaloor Beat, Mankhal Section and total length is proposed for diversion is 1004.23 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0402 Ha
2. Srinagar RF block compt No. 330 Tumaloor Beat, Mankhal Section and total length is proposed for diversion is 1883.84 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0754 Ha.
3. Masjidgadda RF block compt No. 338 Mankhal Beat, Mankhal Section and total length is proposed for diversion is 209.06 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0084 Ha.

Further it is stated that regarding Imarathkancha RF, the entire block was handed over to Animal Husbandry Department in long back and entire area is under control of the Animal Husbandry Department. There will be no extraction of tree growth in the proposed area for diversion. The above Reserve Forest areas are not falls in the National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. No endangered species of flora and fauna found in the area.
