**FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF SUNITA M. BHAGWAT, IFS.,**  
**CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS/CF, RANGAREDDY CIRCLE,**  
**RANGAREDDY IN MANKHAL AND SHAMSHABAD RANGES ON**  
**Dt:24.08.2020.**

I have inspected the proposed area for laying of 0.1428 Ha in Shamshabad Division for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way of M/s Telesonic Networks Ltd., Hyderabad along with District Forest Officer, Rangareddy Forest Division Officer, Shamshabad and the Officials of M/s Telesonic Networks Ltd., on Dt: 24.08.2020.

The Proposed Forest land for diversion is in (4) RF blocks namely Tumuloor, Srinagar, Masjidgadda & Jalpally alongwith the road side in Shamshabad and Mankhal Ranges of Shamshabad Division. The details are as follows:


1. Tumaloor RF block compt No. 331, Tumaloor Beat, Mankhal Section and total length is proposed for diversion is 1004.23 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0402 Ha.
2. Srinagar RF block compt No.330 Tumaloor Beat, Mankhal Section and length is proposed for diversion is 1883.84 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0754 Ha.
3. Masjidgadda RF block compt No.338 Mankhal Beat, Mankhal Section and length is proposed for diversion is 209.06 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0084 Ha.
4. Jalpally RF block compt No.347 of Pahadisharif Beat, Pahadisharif Section and length is proposed for diversion is 471.11 mtrs and width 0.40 mtrs area comes to 0.0188 Ha.

The total length of proposed Optical Fiber Cable line for diversion is 3568.24 RMT and width is 0.40 Mts and the area comes to an extent of 0.1428 Ha in (4) RF and the balance RF Imarathkancha does not come under the control of Forest Department as the total block was diverted to Animal Husbandry Department vide G.O.Ms.No: 2292, F/A dt:06.09.1965. Hence, the said block was not inspected and the block area was also deleted.

Further, there is no alternative land available for laying of optical fiber cable. The optical cable fiber will be laid meandering along the road side without extraction of any trees in the diverted area.

The above (4) Reserve Forest areas does not fall in the National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc. No endangered species of flora and fauna are found in the area and there is no extraction of tree growth.
