13	Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposals with reasons	<p>As the Project is project multipurpose aimed primarily to provide irrigation facilities to the drought prone upland areas for a command area of 27167.00 Acres for entire crop season along with filling of tanks through canals in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri and to provide drinking water facilities to the en-route villagers, the proposal is recommended in the interest of public and Government, the subject to the following conditions.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) To pay an amount of Rs, 13.171 Lakhs towards NPV @ Rs.6.26 Lakh /Ha as per classification of Forest area.</li> <li>b) To pay Rs, 0.464 lakhs towards extraction charges and tree value as estimated.</li> <li>c) To pay Rs, 3.30 Lakhs towards construction of 33 nos RCC broad based pillars.</li> <li>d) To pay Rs, 0.528 lakhs towards construction of 44 Nos RCC intermediate pillars.</li> </ol>
