- 7.18 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 7.19 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 7.20 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)

10.00 It is therefore, requested that Government of Maharashtra may kindly be moved for approving the Proposal for diversion of 5.00 ha. forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of Police Station Building and Residential Quarters for Police at Bhamragad, Taluka Bhamragad, Dist. Gadchiroli in the State of Maharashtra under section 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
