


Site inspection report

For the purpose of widening & strengthening of Bikramganj-Dawath- Maliyabag-Nawanagar-Dumraon Road from KM 219 + 265 to KM 240 + 200 in Buxar District, a proposal for diversion of 22.14 Hectare of forest land has been submitted by Executive Engineer, N.H. Division, Gaya under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980. I have inspected the site on 03.06.2021 with Range Officer of Forest, Buxar and the concerned Assistant Engineer of N.H. Division. As per the proposal, the forest land to be diverted is situated alongside the road. Widening is to be done on both sides of the existing road. The area of proposed forest land to be diverted has been calculated on Formation width/Embankment. For this work only 22.14 Hectare of forest land will be diverted, the calculation of which is attached as annexure-II of the proposal. During strengthening total 752 trees will be required to be felled. The species wise detail of enumeration list is attached with the proposal.

During inspection no endangered/unique species of flora and fauna has been found. There is no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment is located near the site and also no National park/wildlife sanctuary is situated in their area.

Bikramganj-Dumraon is a very important road of Buxar District which connects Rohtas district. Due to heavy traffic on this road, widening & strengthening of this road is very much essential and requirement of proposed forest land is the barest minimum. On the date of inspection it was found that no work in violation of the Act has been carried out. Due to heavy traffic pressure and also for the development of the area, the proposal is required to be cleared.
