

Site Inspection Report

A proposal has been received by this office from GAIL (User Agency) under FC Act for diversion of 22.6500ha. forest land (Forest Land 4.5120ha. & Jungle-Jhari 18.1380 ha.) for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dharma Gas Pipeline. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by undersigned on 28.11.2018. It is found that the land required by User Agency is Miscellaneous forest which includes Protected forest as well as GMJJ measuring 22.6500ha. During site inspection, it has been found that 2158 trees (in Chas Range-1174, Bokaro Range-77 & Peterwar Range-907) (submitted in enumeration list) are present on the said land which need to be either removed or get trimmed.

No protected archaeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monuments were located on the said project area.

No rare/endangered unique species of flora and fauna were found during the inspection in the diverted area for the said project.
