13 Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposals with reasons

The proposed area for the project is 29.9804 Ha (23.043 Ha in WL and 6.9373 Ha ESZ) as proposed by the User agency in this division is barest minimum area and which is unavoidable for the proposed project, the project is useful for agriculture production and large areas are in the grip of fluorosis, a shattering diseased caused by high fluoride content in water and hence, the essential need of these areas is whole some drinking water is required for people of Nalgonda, Suryapet and Rangareddy Districts of Telangana. This proposal is **recommended** subject to following conditions.

- The user agency may be instructed to take up the work during day time only i.e., from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
- The user agency may be instructed not to leave any waste/excess material inside the Tiger Reserve which may effect wild animals.
- The User agency may also instructed to use the sound proof machinery to operate inside the Tiger Reserve.
- Only existing Cart tracks, Roads, Foot Paths in the Forest Area shall be utilized for movement of men and machinery.
- The clearance of bush growth etc., shall be kept to bare minimum.
- The felled material (trees, fuel timber and pulp if any) is the property of the Department and the User agency shall bear the felling, transportation charges, etc.
- Supply of water for forestry activities and wildlife purpose.
- Soil erosion preventive measure has to be taken by the User agency.
