The area is mostly sparse vegetation and is situated in the fringe of Tiger Reserve. The area is highly degraded, has very small no. of fauna (mostly herbivores) and rarely any Carnivore. Biodiversity is very less as the rainfall in the area is very poor. This permanent source of water in the reservoir would help flora and fauna in the area to regenerate and also help in reducing the man-animal conflict in the area. Therefore, the project is recommended subject to the conditions laid down by DFO in Part-II.
