

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The Site Inspection for the proposal for Diversion of Forest Land for the purpose of **Extension of Downstream Dyke on South Bank of Bogibeel Bridge** in Dehingmukh RF under Dibrugarh Forest Division was carried out by the undersigned on 19.02.2018. During the inspection, it was found that the Forest Land required by the User Agency is 20.5 Ha. The proposed area is selected on the open Reserve Forest where the density of the Forest is very less and thereby requiring minimum felling of trees and disturbance to the Wildlife will be nil. The requirement of the Forest land is unavoidable and barest minimum for the Project. The area proposed for diversion does not form part of any Wildlife Sanctuary. The area has no importance from protected archaeological point of view and there is no heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument along the area proposed for Diversion.
