## LAYING OF OPTICAL FIBRE CABLE ON KATORIA- JHAJHA ROAD SITE INSPECTION REPORT BY DCF

The proposed forest land for diversion lies on Katoria-Jhajha road which is notified as protected forest by Government of Bihar vide Notification no.- 921 E dt. 28<sup>th</sup> August 1997. The proposed forest area for diversion is 0.2055 hectare. As per enquiry report of forest officials and information provided by user agency, there is no record of any protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. No trees are required to be cut during implementation of the project. The user agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Forest Conservation Act and Indian Forest Act. This is the bare minimum forest land required for the project and unavoidable.
