The proposed area involves diversion of **0.015 Hectare** in Gaya Forest Division, Gaya. This is the bare minimum of forest land required for the project and has no other alternative to bye-pass. Diversion of this forest land area for the project (Non-Forestry activity) may not much affect the local flora of the area.
