This proposal involves laying of Transmission Line from Ramchandarpur-Jadugora involving diversion of 3.89 ha of Reserve Forest, 2.215 ha Protected forest and 2.888 ha of Jungle-Jhadi land, a total of 8.993 ha and involves cutting of large number of trees.
