Inspection Report for Upgradation of Road and Bridge at Km 3/434-4/074 (640mt x 7.50 = 4800 sqmt) 0.48 Ha in Thandavakulam to Nadukottaimedu road, in Puthupattinam RF bit I Sirkali Range in Wildlife Division, Nagapattinam

I have inspected the Puthupattinam Reserve Forest Bit I, Notified in the Government letter No.II (2) Forest and Fisheries Letter No.1934/82 on Extent of 282.890 on dt.10.03.1982 and found that it has sparse growth of *Prosopis Juliflora*. Other than that, there is no native vegetation observed in the proposed area. The Thandavankulam village is a fishermen hamlet situated on the village and connected the Nadukottaimedu village. Therefore, I enclose the recommendation of the Wildlife Warden, Nagapattinam and recommended for the diversion, as the proposed Thandavankulam to Nadukottaimedu road will give connectivity to around 10000 people living the village of Puthupattinam, Palaiyar and Madavamedu.
