13. Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.

This is the bare minimum forest land required for the project. The amount realized from the user agency in the form of NPV shall be utilized for conservation, protection, and management of forest in this division. The green belt will be created through the amount realized from the user agency as Compensatory afforestation work and it will help in the increasing green cover.

The proposed area involves diversion of 2.064 Ha in Gaya Forest Division, Gaya. This is the bare minimum of forest land required for the project and has no other alternative to bye-pass. Diversion of this forest land area for the project (Non-Forestry activity) may not much affect the local flora of the area. The User Agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Act till the date of inspection.

In light of the above mentioned facts and keeping the cognizance that Gaya District falls under the Naxal Affected area and as per the prescribed provisions, I recommend positively for the approval of this proposal. Therefore this proposal for diversion of forest land may be approved with necessary conditions and directions.
