FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF THE DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, MEDAK IN RESERVE FOREST LAND ON 09.02. 2022.

Today I have proceed along with the Forest Range Officer, Ramayampet and their field staff have inspected the Reserve Forest areas proposed for diversion of 3.4869 Ha Forest land in RFs for construction of Shankarampet branch canal system including distributary network in Ibrahimpur RF. As detailed below:

The said area is passing through Ibrahimpur RF's. The canopy of these areas is 0.2 to 0.4. There are no trees felling required in the said proposed diversion area.

I have searched for other alternatives, but there is no alternative land available except the present proposal. This is the barest minimum area that is required for construction of Shankarampet branch canal system including distributary network area i.e., in 3.4869 Ha.

During my field inspection of the proposed area is falling in Compt. No. 152 and 165 of Rukkumpur Beat of Ibrahimpur Section of Ramayampet Range and it is noticed that the proposed canal has been executed by the user agency without any proper permission from the Forest Department in the year 2019 the extent of 2.8511 Ha area for the violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980.
