Ltd, Rajabagicha, Cuttack which has been approved by Govt. of India (Stage-II) vide Letter No. 8(21) 5/99 FCE dt. 13.7.2009. The User Agency has fulfilled all the terms and conditions stipulated by Govt. of India, MOEF as per Stage-II Order. The DGPS Survey maps prepared by ORSAC and pillar posting over 4.9 ha approved quarry are in Baniabandha RF has been completed. The User Agency has already deposited Rs 2,77,200/- towards Regional Wildlife management Plan. The User Agency has obtained clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) Odisha under the provision EIA Notification, 2006 and 2009and subsequent amendment there to under various guidelines of GOI, MoEF. The UA has obtained necessary clearance form State Pollution Control Board Odisha, Cuttack. Tree felling has already been completed by OFDC Ltd during 2010 and the UA has deposited the operational cost and 25% ESH cost of with the tree royalty. The User Agency has submitted Part-I, II, III and Site specific Wild Life Conservation Plan for getting clearance from National Board for Wild Life. Hence keeping in view of the facts stated above, the project proposal for approach road and parking zone is strongly recommended for obtaining approval of GOI, MoEF under the provision of FC, Act, 1980.
