A proposal has received by this office from VTL on dated 03/05/18 2018 for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 0.7511 Ha. of forest land non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along with road on on Kora Jahanabad-Amuli Modh-Jonhia Chauraha-Shahbajpur, Jonhia Chauraha-Bandhwa Tiraha-Laluli, Bandhwa Tiraha-Bahua Total Length 72.5 KM. & 0.7511 Ha. In Forest Division/Social Forestry Division Fatehpur, District: Fatehpur, UP

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 03/05/18

On inspection of this site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a RF/Un-Classed/Protect forest measuring of 0.7511Ha.
