13. Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reas This is the bare minimum forest land required for the project. The amount realized

from the user agency in the form of NPV shall be utilized for conservation, protection, and management of forest in this division. The green belt will be created through the amount realized from the user agency as Compensatory afforestation work and it will help in the increasing green cover.

The proposed area involves diversion of 0.02466 ha in Nalanda Forest Division, Biharsharif. This is the barest minimum of forest land required for the instant project and has no other alternative to bye-pass. Diversion of these forest land areas for this project (non forestry activity) may not much affect the local flora of the area. The User Agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Act.

In the light of the above mentioned facts and keeping the fact that Nalanda District is fall under the rural area and as per the prescribed provisions I recommend positively for the approval of this instant proposal with Penal provisions of the Act. Therefore this instant proposal for diversion of forest land may be approved with necessary conditions and directions.
