

**Site Inspection Report By Narendra Kumar Singh, Conservator of
Forests, Chitrakootdham Circle, Banda on**
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal named FP/UP/WATER/152706/2022 has been received by this office from **Uttar Pradesh JAL NIGAM, (Rural)** for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 1.00 ha. Mahoba + 5.30 ha. Hamirpur = 6.30 ha. Of Forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for **Construction of Water Distribution pipe line along different roads, under Ptayora Danda group of Village Drinking Water Supply Scheme Jal Jeevan Mission Govt of India, District: Mahoba & Hamirpur.** The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated **17.06.2022**
On inspection of the site it is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/PF measuring **6.30 ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.


