A proposal named FP/UP/WATER/152122/2022 has been received by this office from Uttar Pradesh Water Supply And Sanitation Mission, Lucknow (UP) for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 4.70583 ha. Of Forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for Laying of Water Distribution line along different Roads, Under Raipura Group of Villages Drinking Water Scheme of Jal Jeevan Mission of Govt. of india, in District Chitrakoot. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 18.06.2022.

On inspection of the site it is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/PF measuring Reserved Forest 4.10208 ha.+ Protected Forest 0.60375 ha. =Total 4.70583 ha.
