

**Site Inspection Report By Narendra Kumar Singh, Conservator of
Forests, Chitrakootdham Circle, Banda on 18.06.2022**

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal named FP/UP/WATER/152122/2022 has been received by this office from **Uttar Pradesh Water Supply And Sanitation Mission, Lucknow (UP)** for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 4.70583 ha. Of Forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for **Laying of Water Distribution line along different Roads, Under Raipura Group of Villages Drinking Water Scheme of Jal Jeevan Mission of Govt. of india, in District Chitrakoot.** The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on **dated 18.06.2022.**

On inspection of the site it is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/PF measuring **Reserved Forest 4.10208 ha.+ Protected Forest 0.60375 ha. =Total 4.70583 ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.


