The prevailing vegetation forest growth is categorized under the group 3C/C2e(iii) Moist Peninsular Valley Sal, Eco Value Class- I, Canopy density varing from 0.2 to 0.8. The average density is about 0.6. The prevailing vegetation consist of like sal its associates.

Position of Wildlife	The applied forest land involved Thakurani & Siddhamath Reserved Forest. is the dwelling habitat for bear, barking dear, hyena, porcupine and etc. Movement of wild Elephant is seen within 5 KM distance from the Mining Lease. The applied site falls under Elephant habitat zone- 2 as per the book titled Remote Sensing Application for characterization of elephant habitat and corridor in Odisha and parts of Bihar published by ORSAC in September, 1999.

Further, an area of 42.423 ha of non-forest land recorded as forest as on 25.10.1980 in Govt. record has also been broken up prior to 10.03.2015 within Bamebari Iron & Mn. Mines.  In consonance to the approved Review of Mining Plan 2.900 Nos of saplings has been planted over an area of 1.20 ha for the block year 2020-21. Further, the concurrent reclamation by back filling of exhausted quarry is being carried out since 1st Apr'2010 as per approved Review of Mining Plan. The same is continuing and an area measuring 14.70 ha have been back filled up to 2020-2021. The afforestation
