JOINT SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A proposal has been submitted under the Indian Forest Conservation Act-1980 for use of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction & Maintenance of road from L039-Kakuthal to Brannar, Stage Ilby Executive Engineer PMGSY Bramulla. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by us on 14-10-2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest land measuring 0.16082. In the land proposed by the User Agency is the barest minimum required for the project and also the area so proposed doesn't house any unique flora & fauna.
