

# SITE INSPECTION REPORT BY CCF, AJMER

(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

Name of Project: Diversion of 3.50 ha. forest land for Laying of Under ground of 8"/12" Dia Carbon Steel Gas Pipeline Along the NH-8 Road Within the Existing Row from Tapping point NH-8 Jaipur-Ajmer Bypass tiraha at Gagwana to Mangliyawas Tapping point (Length 35.00 KM) in District-Ajmer (Rajasthan) by Indraprastha Gas Limited. FP/RJ/PIPELINE/147451/2021
