SITE INSPECTION REPORT

For the construction of Two Lane Road Form Baysi-Bahadurganj-Dighalbank section of SH-99 in Kishanganj District, a proposal for diversion of 19.337 Hectare of Forest land has been submitted by the D.G.M. (Tech) BSRDCL PIU- Katihar. I have inspected the site on dated 06.06.2022 with Range Officer of Forests, Kishanganj and Deepak Mandal, SDO, BSRDCL, Abhinav Srivastav, Environmental Engineer. BSRDCL consultant. The area for diversion of Forest land is 19.337 Ha. Total number of trees to be cut left and Right hand side are 518 and Translocation 572 trees. The enumeration list is attached here by. During inspection no endangered/unique species of flora and fauna has been found Also no protected archaeological/heritage site/defense establishment is located near the site.

Baysi-Bahadurganj-Dighalbank section of SH-99 Road is a very important road; the Forest area for diversion is barest minimum & no violation of Forest Conservator Act seen at the site.

I recommend the diversion of land for the proposed site.
