- 2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- 2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 2.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

2.2 Compensatory Afforestaton:

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 5.00 degraded forest land of Protected Forest land in Survey No.99, Gut No.156, at Village Shei, Tal. Shahapur, Dist. Shahapur at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- b) The non forest land which has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department.
- 2.3 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years.

The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

2.4 NPV:-

- 2.8 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 2.9 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 2.10 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 2.11 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.12 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.13 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.

The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.

The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central 2.9

Government.

2.10 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.

- 2.11 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.12 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.13 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.14 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project
- 2.15 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of
- 2.16 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.17 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
