3	Specific recommendations of the concerned Chief Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with detailed reasons.	<p>The proposed road passes through the forest land at six different locations in the three ranges of Pune Forest Division. At four locations it is underground (through tunneling) and at two locations it is over ground (on surface). The project also involves demolition of two buildings of forest department in Paud Range. The project is recommended for acceptance subject to compliance of the following conditions:</p> <p>(1) A green belt of indigenous tree species should be developed over ground wherever tunneling is done on both private (acquired) and forest land.</p> <p>(2) The muck from tunnel digging should not be dumped anywhere near forests.</p> <p>(3) The Project Authority should compensate for the loss of two buildings in Paud Range by (bearing) the cost of construction afresh.</p> <p>(4) The area is inhabited by Wildlife like leopards, Indian Gaur, Chital, Hares, Jackals, Reptiles, etc. Hence, the Project Authority should provide for three vehicles for three ranges for patrolling & rescue of wild animals where the proposed road passes through.</p> <p>(5) A corpus fund of Rs. 2.00 cr. should be deposited with the Pune Forest Division for maintenance of newly developed Transit Treatment Centre (TTC) at Bavdhan, Pune</p> <p>(6) The vehicles belonging the forest department, forest officers & forest staff on duty should not be levied toll on the proposed ring road.</p>
