


Inspection report of CCF Northern Circle.

As part of the hill highway Project Edaparamba Kolichal Road in Kasargod range, Kasargod Division was inspected on 15/07/2023 along with DFO Kasargod, RFO Kasargod and staff. The total area of diversion proposed is 4.332 Ha. The diversion is in two reaches. First reach is 3km length (3.624 ha) and the second reach is 600m length (0.708 Ha.). The width proposed for the road is 12m for both stretches. After covering the first reach the second reach starts after about 700m distance in the revenue land. The diversion proposal is proposed along an existing road of about 3m width. The widening is proposed from the center of the existing road to about 6 m width towards both sides. The proposal falls in the Adoor Reserve Forest.

First reach is starting from Evanthoor to Pandy Bajanmandir. The works for ladies barrack of Forest Department was ongoing at Pandy area, where this stretch is ending. The first reach is 600m along the existing road which covers natural vegetation on each side. For implementing the project 35 trees need to be felled.

Second reach starts from Pallathumpara to Pallanji Mahogany plantation and is proposed along the existing road which covers areas of teak plantations, natural vegetation, Mahogany plantation. In this stretch 347 number of trees need to be felled. The proposed roads are passing through moderately undulating terrain.
