The project envisages diversion of 1.2 Hectare of the forest land at Kuligadh (Drabshalla) in the favour of PIU Khellani, NHIDCL for "Construction of Bi-directional tunnel at km 83rd of length 495 m including approach road of 664 m and a Major Bridge of 110 m from km 82+675 to km 82+925 on NH 244 in UT of Jammu & Kashmir". The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by the undersigned on 26-04-2020.
- 2. On inspection of the site, it is found that land required by the user agency is Forest land measuring **1.2 hectares**.
- 3. The requirement of the land proposed by the user agency in col. 2 Part-I is unavoidable and bare minimum required for the project.

Specific Recommendation:

- The User Agency has not demarcated the forest area by installing R.C.C pillars. An estimate in this regard has been prepared and is Annexed herewith as additional document. The estimated amount to the tune of Rs. 1.20 lakh shall be provided by the User Agency to the Forest department for the purpose
