The proposed road is passing through interior forest area and the surrounding areas covering with good flora and fauna and the road dead end with the village Loddiguda.</p> <p>This route has no alternatives and the road width of 10 Mtrs proposed by the User agency is not necessary in view of the interior location of the connecting villages. The vehicular traffic is also negligible and hence in view of protection of forest and requirement of up gradation of road, it is recommended the width of road for 6 Mtrs instead of 10 Mtrs as proposed by the User agency and the diversion area reduced to1.29996 Ha. As per justification given by user agency and the field conditions, the barest minimum and unavoidable area for the project is 1.29996 Ha.</p>

The road connectivity improves the standard of life of the interior tribes and facilitates to transport agricultural produce to the nearest market centres.</p> <p>Thus, the area i.e 1.29996 Ha for diversion towards up gradation and formation of road for BT road with reduced width of 6.00 meters over a length of 2.1666 Km, which is falling in Sathnala & Manikgarh Reserve forests in Adilabad division is recommended considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions.</p>
