## Inspection report of the District Forest Officer, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri

Inspected the area proposed for diversion of 0.1902 Ha Forest land in Malkapur forest Block in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri Division for construction of Turkapally Canal system including distributor network in favour of I & CADD Department on along with field staff on 14.04.2021.

The area proposed to be diverted is demarcated on the ground. The terrain is undulating to gently rolling. The soils are generally gravel and hard.

The existing forest is Tropical dry deciduous Forest of 0.10 density. The flora found in the area is Chloroxylon swietenia, Albizia amara, Casia fistula, Tectona grandis, Azadirachta indica Wrightia tinctoria, Butea monosperma, etc., but adopted to scrub based on edaphic and climatic factors and the fauna found is pea-fowl, Wild boar, Snakes, Monitor lizard etc. Since, the area proposed is primarily to provide irrigation facilities to the drought prone upland areas along with filling of tanks through canals, the soil erosion is negligible.

There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna in the area proposed for diversion. There is no protected archaeological heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. The area does not form part of National park, Wildlife sanctuary, Bio sphere reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor, etc.

The area required by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. No work in violation of Forest Conservation Act is taken place. If the proposed forests land is diverted, the impact on the adjoining reserve forest is negligible.
