INSPECTION REPORT

The site for construction of 400 KV D/C Transmission line from North Karanpura to Gaya for diversion of 181.6526 Ha. Forest land (In Chatra South Forest Division- P.F-88.677 Ha. + GM(JJ)-31.2836 Ha. Total- 119.8806 Ha. & in Chatra North Forest Division- P.F-51.929 Ha., + GM(JJ)-9.843 Ha. Total- 61.772 Ha.) was inspected on 14.09.2022 Divisional Forest Officer, Chatra North Division, Divisional Forest Officer Chatra South Division, DGM and Assistant Manager, N.K.T.L Hazaribag, North Karanpura to Gaya 400KV D/C Transmission Line, Range Forest Officer, and other subordinate officers and staffs of forest as well as useragencies. The soil along the proposed Transmission line is highly vulnerable to soil erosion. So proper soil conservation measures should be taken. The proposal is meant for construction and development of transmission system and also to mitigate the actual shortage of power due to inadequate transmission infrastructure in the area. A large no. of people will be benefited by this project. In view of the aforesaid facts, the diversion proposal for proposal for 181.6526 Ha. Forest land for Construction of 400 KV D/C North Karanpura to Gaya Transmission line is recommended.
