3.0 The proposal has been initiated by Shri Prabhatchandra Jain, National President, Bharatvarshiya Digambar Jain Tirthkshetra Committee, Mumbai for Construction of Railings and New Black Stone Staircase on footpath from Zhari Parshwanath Digambar Jain Mandir to up to Wildlife Passage on side railing and Footpath repair in the Yashwantrao Chavan Sagreshwar wildlife Sanctuary.

Proposal for diversion of Forest land for repair of existing Pathway 0.0246 ha. Existing steps in this area 0.0216 ha. and maintenance of Existing 3 Temples, one Shelter Area 0.501 ha. Total proposed work on existing pathway area 0.0963 ha. and new Construction of railings and new Black stone staircase on footpath from Zhari Parshwanath Digambar Jain Mandir to up to Wildlife Passage one side railings and Footpath repair. In the Wildlife passage only footpath work end of Wildlife



passage to Hill top edge both side railings and Black stone staircase on footpath. Hill top Edge to Via-Shridhar Kevali paduka Jain Mandir up to Village Kundal boundary footpath repair whith black stone staircase work in Village Kundal F.G.No-119 required area-0.2422 ha. Tal. Palus . And Village kundal boundary to Giri Parshwanth Digambar Jain Mandir footpath repair work and maintenance of one temple in Vilage-Kumbhargaon F.G.No-127 required area 0.0242 ha. Tal.Kadegaon Dist. Sangali. Total required forest area 0.2664 ha.

9.00 In View of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the sectin-2 (ii) of the forest (Conservation) Act,1980 subject to the following conditions:-

- 9.1 Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged:
- 9.2 Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 1.00 ha. degraded forest land in Compt.No.3 & forest Gut/No. 142 at Village Khumbhargaon, Taluka Kadegaon, district Sangli at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- 9.3 The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory Afforestation, at the current wage rate, to the State Forest Department. The Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years;

9.4 **NPV**

- (a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 0.2664 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008, and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt-II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letterNo.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5.3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 and 06/01/2022 in this regard.
- (b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the Report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency Shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 9.5 For Violation of the FCA, 1980 as penalty, the user agency will defray the cost of equal to NPV of Forest land per hectare for of each year of violence from the dated of actual diversion as reported by the inspecting officer with maximum up to (5) times the NPV plus 12 percent simple interest till the deposited is made in accordance with Govt. of India advisory number 11-42/2017- FC, dated29/1/2018

- 9.6 All The funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)
- 9.7 The State Government should confirm, if any further construction in the forest land has been taken place by the User Agency after submission of the extant proposal for regularization of the forest land.
- 9.8 The User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;
- 9.9 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- 9.10 The User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labours and the Staff Working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- 9.11 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet height reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar;
- 9.12 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- 9.13 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the Proposal;
- 9.14 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- 9.15 No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;
- 9.16 Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict Supervision of the State Forest Department;
- 9.17 The State Government shall ensure complete shall ensure complete settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its Guidelines issued in this regard along with the compliance of Stage-I approval;
- 9.18 The User Agency in consultation with the State Government shall create and maintain alternate habitat/home for the avifauna, who's nesting trees are to be cleared in this project. Bird's nest artificially made out of eco-friendly material shall be used in the area, including forest area and human settlements, adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project;
- 9.19 The user agency shall Submit recommendation of CWLW.
- 9.20 The User Agency shall submit six monthly self-compliance reports as on 1st January and 1st July of every year to the GOI office as well as to the Nodal Officer of the State;
