Regulation of Forest

Notification under Tamil Nadu Forest Act.

Declaration of Kayamalai Forest Block in Manapparai taluk, Tiruchirappalli district as reserved forests.

(Letter No. 20091/FR 111/80-3, Forests and Fisheries, 12th September 1980.)

No. 11 (2)/FR 11/5528/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the boundaries of which are specified in the schedule below as reserved forest with effect on and from the 8th January 1981.

SCHEDULE.

Tiruchirappalli district, Manapparai taluk, No. 130. Velakkurichi village.

Name of the forest block Kayamalai.

Area of the forest block—353.30 acres or 142.98 hectares.

North.—Starting from the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 187-1 and 186-2 of No. 131, Kanjanaickenpatti village and S.F. No. 171-2 of No. 130, Velakkurichi village which is also the south western corner of S.F. No. 171-2 of the said Velakkurichi village, the boundary runs generally towards east along the southern side of S.F. No. 171-2, western side of S.F. No. 170-1 A, western, southern and eastern sides of S.F. No. 170-1 B, eastern side of S.F. No. 170-1 A, southern side of S.F. No. 171-2, western side of S.F. No. 171-3 A, western and southern sides of S.F. No. 171-3 B, trijunction of S.F. Nos. 170-3 B, 171-2 and 176-13 B, southern side of S.F. Nos. 176-13 B, 177-1 B, 190-4 B, 193-5 B and 214-1 B to the north-western corner of S.F. No. 220-1 all of the said Velakkurichi village.

East.—Thence the boundary runs generally towards south along the western side of S.F. Nos. 220-1, 2-A, 2 B, 3, 4-B, 10 and 18, western and southern sides of S.F. No. 220-19, western side of S.F. Nos. 223-1, 2, 6, 7, 9, 12, 13,

Nos. 121-17, 16, 14, 13, 12, 3, 2 and 1, trijunction of S.F. Nos. 121-1, 124 and 123-1, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 123-1, southern and eastern sides of S.F. Nos. 131-4 and 3, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 131-2, eastern side of S.F. No. 130, trijunction of S.F. Nos. 130, 91 and 132-7, southern side of S.F. No. 132-7, southern and eastern side of S.F. No. 132-6, southern, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 132-5, eastern side of S.F. No. 132-3, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 132-1, eastern side of S.F. No. 133-4, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 133-3, eastern side of S.F. No. 131-12 and 9, eastern and northern sides of S.F. Nos. 166-2, 166-7 and 166-2, western side of S.F. Nos. 163-2 and 3, northern side of S.F. No. 163-21, all of No. 130, Velakkurichi village, thence along the eastern side of S.F. Nos. 199-1, 187-2 and 187-1 all of No. 131, Kanjanaickenpatti village to the starting point.

Rights admitted.—(1) A cart track (width 25 feet or 7.6 metres) from Karaipatti to Kanjanaickenpatti village passes through the forest block in S.F. Nos. 234, 122, 123 and 1. The length of the cart track is 374 metres. The villages of Karaipatti, Velakkurichi and Kanjanaickenpatti are using the cart-track. The above cart track also being used by the buses plying from Manapparai, Sendurai and Thuvarekurichi to Natham routes. This cart track in the forest block enters in S.F. No. 234 and runs through S.F. Nos. 122, 123-3 and 1 with the following bearing and distances. This is admitted in the forest block without any hindrance to the forest block.

(2) A footpath (5 feet or 1.5 metres width) length from Karaipatti to Velakkurichi village passes through S.F. Nos. 234, 233, 232, 230, 227, 226, 222 and 221 and joins with the another cart track coming from Kallakampatti Kanjanaickenpatti village. The villagers of Kallakampatti, Karaipatti and Velakkurichi are using this foot path. This foot path in the forest block is admitted without any hindrance.

(5) A cart track (25 feet or 7.6 metres width and 562 feet length) from Kallakampatti to Kanjanakkenpatti through S.P. Nos. 168, 167, 166-1, 163-1 of Kayamala Forest. The villagers of Kanjanakkenpatti and Velkurichi are using this cart track. This cart track in the forest block is admitted without any hindrance to the forest block. This cart track runs in the forest block in S.P. No. 168 and runs through S.P. Nos. 167, 166-1, 163-1 with the following bearings and distances:—

(6) A footpath (5 feet or 1.5 metres width) from the main cart track already described in easement right No. 3 runs towards north to reach the cultivation lands. The ryots are using this footpath. (5) A footpath (5 feet or 1.5 metres width) from the main cart track from Kallakampatti to Kanjanakkenpatti village diverted from the S.P. No. 168 in Station No. 17 already described in easement right No. 53 runs towards southern side of the forest block to reach these cultivation lands. The ryots are using this footpath. This footpath in the forest block is admitted without any hindrance to the forest block. This footpath is diverted from magnetic bearing station No. 17 with the following bearing and distances:—

(6) A footpath (5 feet or 1.5 metres width) from the foot path already described in easement right No. 4 diverting from S.P. No. 167 in Magnetic bearing station No. 24 runs towards east and then towards south and joins with the main cart track already described in easement right No. 3 in Magnetic bearing station No. 18. The ryots are using this footpath to reach the cultivation lands. This footpath in the forest block is admitted without any hindrance to the forest block. This footpath runs towards east and south with the following bearings and distances:—

(7) A footpath (5 feet or 1.5 metres width) from the main cart track already described in easement right No. 3 runs towards north to reach the cultivation lands. The ryots are using this footpath. This footpath is diverting from S.P. No. 168 from magnetic bearing station No. 17. This foot path is admitted in the footpath without any hindrance to the forest block. This footpath runs towards north with the following bearings and distances:—

No. 542-1, northern and western sides of S.F. No. 540-2, northern side of S.F. No. 538-2, eastern, northern and western side of S.F. No. 538-1, northern side of S.F. Nos. 211-5 and 211-4, eastern and northern sides of S.F. No. 210-1, eastern side of S.F. No. 80, southern and eastern sides of S.F. No. 209, southern and eastern sides of S.F. Rights admitted.—(1) Right is allowed to the public for the use of Panchayat road passing west to east in the southern and S.F. No. 599 of Thuvankurichi village cutting also S.F. No. 598-2 (an enclave with in S.F. No. 599) abutted by station No. 1, 49 links (9.8 metres) south of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 472, 473 and 539 on the western border of S.F. No. 599 and emerging out of the 1st half portion of road at a point 801 links (10 metres) south of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 558, 450 and 559 and after passing through non-forest area in S.F. No. 558 (Non-forest areas) again entering the forest limits through station No. 7, 44 links (8.8 metres) south of the trijunction of S.F. No. 1562 and 509 of Thuvankurichi village and S.F. No. 234 of Nallur village proceeding in the same direction (it reaches station No. 9 of the eastern border of S.F. No. 569, 45 links (9 metres) south of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 569 and 570 of Thuvankurichi village and S.F. No. 234 of Nallur village. The length of the 1st half

portion of the road is 5118 links (1029.6 metres) and the second half portion is 2190 links (438.0 metres) with a width of 20 links or 4 metres. The particulars of distance with reference to bearings at each station are furnished below:

Total length of the road in Forest area is 7,300 links or 1470.2 metres.

This road connects Thuvankurichi village with Nallur village.

(For access to the patta field S.F. No. 598-1 an exclusive with in S.F. No. 599 the pattadar will be permitted to use the footpath abutted by station No. 2, 49 links (9 metres) east of the western F line of S.F. No. 598-1 from the above road to the field which is at a distance of 54 links (10.9 metres) bearing 13.50.

(2) Right is allowed to the public for access to the temple called Malayandi Koi in an area of 100 by 100 square links (0.10 cents or 0.04 hectare) in S.F. No. 397 of Yagapuram village. The temple is led by a footpath 5 links (1 metre) wide abutted by station 27,364 links (73 metres) west of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 410-2, 410-3 and 397 on the eastern F line of S.F. No. 397. The bearing distance particulars are as follows:

The Diety is represented hereby some spears erected on ground and the villages of Nallur and Yagapuram come here for worship.

(3) Right is allowed to the public for the use of the cart-track in the eastern half of S.F. No. 233 of Nallur village running north to south connecting 'Mukkanpalam' in the Virallimalai-Madurai Highways Road with Nallur village on the south abutted by Station No. 20, 101 links (20.3 metres) east of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 414 and 421 of Yagapuram village and S.F. No. 233 of Nallur village on the northern F line of S.F. No. 233 (10.5 metres) east of the trijunction of S.F. Nos. 233, 3 and 4. The width of the cart-track is 20 links (4 metres). The bearings and distance particulars of the cart-track are:
