In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests(MOEF) Government of India letter no. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009 where in the MOEF issued guide lines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights Act 2006 (FRA for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF s letter dated 5th February 2013 where in MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.77 Ha of Forest land in Pulapathur R.F proposed to be diverted in the favour of Executive Engineer, PRI Division, Rajampet (A Govt. of India Enterprises) (name of user agency) for formation of road from Baggidipalli to Yakaropalli Village of Pulapathur Grama Panchayat of Rajampet Mandal (purpose of diversion of forest land) in YSR Rajampet district falls within jurisdiction of Pulapathur Village and Grama Panchayat of Rajampet Mandal.

It is further Certified that:

- The complete process for identification and settlement of Rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 1.77 Hectares of Forest area proposed for Diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee, Grama Sabha (s), Sub-divisional level committee and District level committee are enclosed as annexure A to H.
- The proposals for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications in vernacular/Local languages) have been placed before each concerned Grama Sabha of Forest Dwellers who are eligible under RoFR Act.
- The each of the concerned Grama Sabha (s) has certified that all formalities / Process under the RoFR Act have been carried out and they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensatory and ameliorative measures if any having understood the purposes and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Grama Sabha of Pulapathur Village is enclosed.
- The discussions and decision on such proposals had taken placed only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of members of the Grama Sabha present.
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- The rights of primitive tribal groups and pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguard as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FR Act.

STATEMENT SHOWING CERTIFICATES FROM A TO H

A	A letter from the State Government certifying that complete process for identification and settlement of rights under FRA has been carried out for the entire Forest area proposed for the diversion with a record of all consultations and meetings held.	The proposed area of diversion in Pulapathur RF of Rajampet Range does not fall in the scheduled Tribe area and therefore does not attract the provision of ROFR Act 2006. Consequent on which identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.
B	A letter from the state Government certifying that proposals for such diversions (with full details of the project and its implications in vernacular/ Local languages have been placed before each concerned Gram sabha of Forest dwellers, who are the Eligible under the FRA.	There are no Forest dwellers in the proposed diversion area, hence does not arise.
C	A letter from each of the concerned Grama sabhas indicating that all formalities / processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensatory and the ameliorative measures if any having understood the purpose and the details of proposed.	The resolution passed in the Gram sabha was obtained from Grama Sabha conducted at Pulapathur Village and Gramapanchayath of Rajampet Mandal, Rajampet Dist. duly conducting meeting and required documents / certificates giving their consent to the proposed diversion are submitted. However there are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion.
D	A letter from the state Government certifying that the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been complied and that the Gram sabhas have consented.	The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed and the Grama sabha have given their consent to it.
E	A letter from the state Government certifying that the discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of members of gram sabha presents.	Issue of proposed diversion of Forest land 1.77 Ha. was discussed in Gram sabha. decision was taken in the quorum of minimum 50% of the members of the concerned gram sabha.
F	Obtaining the return consent or rejections of the Gram sabha to the proposal	There are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion, however written consent has been obtained from the Gram sabha of Pulapathur Village and Gramapanchayath of Rajampet Mandal, Rajampet Dist.
G	A letter from the state Government certifying that the rights of primitive tribal groups and pre agricultural communities where applicable have been specifically safe guarded as per the section of 3 (1) of the FRA	There are no cases or Primitive Tribal groups and Pre Agricultural communities, as per the section of 3 (2) of ROFR Act 2006 the Grama Sabha have given their consent for the Forest area in Pulapathur RF, Rajampet Range which is proposed for diversion of 1.77 Ha. Forest land for diversion of forest land for formation of road from Baggidipalli to Yakaropalli Village of Pulapathur Grama Panchayat of Rajampet Mandal.
