I invite kind attention to the subject and references cited. Through the reference 1st cited, certain information has been called for processing renewal application of M/s. Vaidhnav Granites, Chittoor.

In this connection, this office Surveyor has given surveyed sketch duly showing broken area and the remaining information is prepared based on the Approved Mining Plan submitted by lessee. The information as desired in the reference 1st cited is as detailed below:-

- The area already broken-up during the subsistence of mining lease is 0.780 Hectare.
- As per the Mining Plan and based on this office records, the Mineral deposits available in the broken up area is estimated as 18734 Cbm.
- As per the Mining Plan and based on this office records, the estimated quantities proposed to be quarrying as fresh is 1,41,362 Cbm.
- The lessee was in Agreement for regular supply of Granite to local contractors. On behalf of lessee the contractors has established 6 Granite Cutting and Polishing Units with 18 bidders at Arupali Village, Gudipala Mandal, Chittoor Dist. In order to feed the raw material to the Mineral Based Industries and to do scientific and systematic quarrying, the mineral available in the broken area is not sufficient to do quarrying for further lease period. Hence the lessee has to work in the fresh area to meet their requirements and to do quarrying in systematic and scientific manner.
