No.290.--The Right Honourable the Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from 15th August 1901, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification, will be constituted a "reserved forest."

REMARKS.--Admitted rights--

I. Right of way for men, cattle and carts to a width of of eighteen feet over the road from Kundukota to Anchetti is admitted. It enters the reserve at cairn No.127, runs south west and quits it at cairn No.291. It again enters the reserve ~~from~~ ^{at} ~~cairn~~ ^{cairn} No.286, runs in the same direction and quits it at cairn No.276. The total distance in all is four miles.

N.B.--It is an old road and is passable for carts to a great extent though not easy to a small extent but near Forest Department had made a cart-track, which is easier.

II. Right of way for men and cattle to a width of four feet over the undermentioned foot-paths is admitted:-

(1) Foot-path from Javalagiri to Nandimangalam.--It enters the reserve at cairn No.4, runs south for about furlongs and quits it at cairn No.413.

(2) Foot-path from Kumaladur to Madakkallu.--It enters the reserve north-west of cairn No.16, runs south two miles and quits it about three-fourth furlong south-east of cairn No.385.

(3) Foot-path from Kumaladur to Savirapatta.--It enters the reserve between cairns Nos.17 and 18, runs south for about five furlongs and quits it at cairn No.22.

(4) Foot-path from Savirapatta to Sulikunta.--It enters the reserve at cairn No.25, runs south-west for about and one-fourth miles and quits it near cairn No.386.

(5) Foot-path from Padikiniyalam to Sulikunta.--It enters the reserve between cairns Nos.33 and 34, runs south for about one and one-fourth miles and quits it near cairn No.385.

(6) Foot-path from Padikiniyalam to Pani.--It enters the reserve between cairns Nos.39 and 40, runs south about three miles and quits it at cairn No.324.

(7) Foot-path from Gollahalli to Pani.--It enters the reserve at cairn No.72, runs south for about three miles meets the path in item (6) supra, about half a furlong north of its point of exit from the reserve.

(8) Foot-path from Paripettam to Pani.--It enters the reserve at cairn No.82, runs south-west for about quarter miles and meets the path in item (7) supra about a mile south of its point of entrance into the reserve.

(9) Foot path from Mallikarjunadurgam to Gollahalli.--It enters the reserve about one-fourth of a furlong south of cairn No. 96, runs south-west for about three and three-quarter miles and quits it about a chain north-west of cairn No. .

(10) Foot-path from Salivaram to Anchetti.--It enters the reserve about half a furlong east of cairn No.145, runs south-west for about two and a half miles and meets the road in item I, about three chains south of Muthurayanagud

(11) Foot-path from Salivaram to Tamasanhalli.--It enters the reserve about a furlong south-west of the Budhatt cultivation, runs south by west for about two and three-quarter miles and quits it between cairns Nos.256 and 257.

(12) Foot-path from Sivanahalli to Bolamallanakerai(tank).--It enters the reserve about a furlong east by north of the tri-junction of Sivanahalli, Salivaram and Vadakerai villages and runs south by east for about five furlongs to Bolamallanakerai (tank).

(13) Foot-path from Sivanahalli to Manchi.--It enters the reserve about half a mile east by north of the trijunction of Sivanahalli, Salivaram, and Vadakarai villages, runs south-east, south and south-west for about one and three-quarter miles and quits it about half a furlong north-east of cairn No.210.

(14) Foot-path from Tamasanhalli to join the road in item I.--It enters the reserve between cairns Nos.273 and 274, runs north by west for about four furlongs and joins the road about three-quarter furlong south-east of cairn No.281.

(15) Foot-path from Mariyalam to Kundukota.--It enters the reserve north of cairn No.311, runs east for about one and a half miles and joins the road in item I about three chains south of Muthurayanagudi (temple).

(16) Foot-path from Gollahalli to Pani.--It enters the reserve at cairn No.359, runs south-east partly inside and partly outside the reserve boundary for about six furlongs and quits it a quarter furlong south-east of cairn No.353.

Note.---This path will be diverted along the boundary line.

(6) Mutharayana gudi. Situated about three miles north-east of Michetti on the west side of the road in item I and about half a furlong north of the point, where it is crossed by the path in item II(15).

About three chains square in shape, on all the four sides of the temple.

Access is by the road in item I and by the foot-paths in items II (14) and II (15).

The right to use the water of the well situated about half a furlong north-east of the temple and west of the Hebba Halla (stream) for drinking, cooking, bathing and worshipping purposes is admitted. Access to the well is by the road mentioned in item I supra.

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IV.--Right to use the burial and burning grounds, each one chain square, is admitted. The grounds will be *demarcated* out free from reservation and be retained as enclosures. The former is situated about two-and-a quarter furlongs north-west and the latter about quarter of a furlong north-east of cairn No. 382. Access is allowed to them for men only to a width of four feet by a foot-path entering the reserve at cairn No. 382 and running north-west and south-east for about two-and-a-quarter furlongs and quarter of a furlongs respectively.

V. Government patta usufruct right over the following tamarind trees is admitted subject to any rules that may hereafter be passed by the Governor in Council under section 12 (b) of the Forest Act, and also provide that no grant *sale, lease, mortgage* or other alienation of the usufruct shall be made without the sanction of Government in accordance with Section 19 of the Act and that no access shall be had to the trees without the permission of the Forest officers save during the months of January to April both inclusive. The produce may be sold or bartered.
