

This is with reference to the EDS raised by the Nodal Office vide Letter No. Ft.48-3380/2016 (FCA) Dated 26.10.2023 and your office Endst. No. 7689 Dated 31.10.2023 on the subject cited above. In this context the detailed reply is as under:-

Further, The KML file has been corrected and revised KML file has been uploaded against Column No. C in online Part-I.
