TO WHOMSOEVER IT, MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014; and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 0.11 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Power Department, Government of Sikkim, West District, for extension of three phase 11 KV Weasel line and Installation of 25 KVA Outdoor type Distribution Sub-Station along with Extension of LT line at Sakhimdara, Dhoban and Nayapatal (72nd Battalion SSB Outpost along Indo-Nepal Border) at Gyalshing, West Sikkimc. It is further certified that;

- (a) the complete process of recognition and vesting of forest rights under the FRA, 2006 has been carried out for the entire 2.87 hectare of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub- Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.
- (b) the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha or forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA, 2006;
- (c) each of the concerned Gram Sabha, has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. Copies of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of 11-Darap Nambu GPU are enclosed.
- (d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- (e) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3 (2) of tine FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it;
- (f) the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per Section3 (1) of the FRA, 2006.
