


Muck Disposal Management Plan

The preparing FCA Case if there is any activity in the project which involves the digging of land, muck disposal management plan has to be prepared.

It is to Undertake

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2. Quantity of muck to be utilized in the project activities.	Utilization of Muck Generated from Excavation of Earth: About 693999.57m ³ filling required for the filling of embankments. The quantity required for the filling at embankments is more than the quantity of muck generated from earth work. Therefore, the project does not required any land for muck disposal.
3. Balance quantity of muck, which requires disposal / management plan	No Balance Muck.
4. Carriage of muck from the muck generation site to the dumping site.	Not Applicable
