The subject envisages the use of forest land for construction of road from Bhara to Mandhir Mohalla Godha Package No.JK04-521,Stage I & II (Combined).

1. The site inspection of the forest land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 08-01-2021
2. On the inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 0.815 ha.
3. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in column No. 2 of Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
