
Sir,

This is with reference to the EDS raised by HQ New Delhi Vide F. No. FC/HPB/09/79/2022 Dated 20-10-2025 on the subject sited above, the EDS raised has been attended and Para wise reply for the same is as under.

Sr. No.	Observation	Reply
1.	The Letter of Intent (LoI) was valid until 24.08.2025 and has now expired. A valid LoI needs to be submitted.	Valid LOI has been uploaded in online Part-I. The validity period of LOI has been further extended for two years w.e.f. 25-08-2025 onwards.
2.	The DFO has mentioned in Part II that 0.0934 ha of forest land is applied for renewal for the establishment of a stone crusher by M/s Bushahr Laghu Udyog. However, in the title mentioned in Part I, it refers to the renewal of diversion of the stone crusher. The State Government shall clarify whether the proposal is for renewal or for the establishment of a new stone crusher.	The instant proposal is for renewal of lease for already established Stone Crusher which was approved by the MoEF&CC vide Approval letter No. 9-414/97-ROC dated 18.08.2006. Further, Part-II pertains to DFO concerned.
3.	In the component-wise break-up provided in the updated Part-I, 0.011 ha has been proposed for the approach road. However, the KML file for the road has not been submitted along with the proposal. The KML file must be uploaded on the	The revised KML file with approach road has been uploaded in online Part-I

	PARIVESH portal and the Ministry should be duly informed.	
4.	It is observed that the same user agency has submitted Proposal No. FP/HP/MIN/34194/2018 for the diversion of 2.1532 ha of Protected Forest Land (comprising 1.4612 ha for mining lease and safety zone, 0.3400 ha for the approach road, and 0.3520 ha for stacking of raw material). The present proposal pertains to the diversion of forest land for a crusher plant and a road. The State Government is therefore requested to clarify whether these two proposals are interlinked. If they are, the reason for submitting them separately may kindly be provided.	The two proposals are interlinked and submitted by the same user agency. The reason for submitting them separately is that the one proposal is for renewal of previously approved lease for existing Stone Crusher for which Form-B of FCA, 1980 applies and another proposal is for diversion of additional land for which Form-A of FCA, 1980 applies.
5.	It is noted from the reply submitted by the State Government in response to the EDS raised by the Regional Office of this Ministry on 30.01.2025 that the user agency has applied for obtaining the NOC from the concerned Road Department, and that the same will be submitted prior to Stage-II approval. The State Government is therefore requested to furnish the said NOC at the earliest.	The process of obtaining NOC is under process with MoRTH and same will be issued after depositing access permission Fee of Rs. 3.00 Lacs from National Highway. The NoC will be submitted after getting Stage-I/In-Principal Approval from MoEF&CC.
6.	As per the DSS report, there is a discrepancy between the previously approved area and the area now proposed for renewal. The State Government is requested to submit the correct and updated KML file accordingly.	Updated KML with necessary correction has been uploaded in online Part-I
7.	As per the DSS report, certain structures are visible within the proposed forest area. The State Government is requested to provide specific comments and clarification regarding the same.	The structures visible on the proposed site is already established Stone Crusher, for which the online proposal no FP/HP/IND/35171/2018 for renewal is pending with MoEF&CC.

This is requested to your good self that kindly expedite the said FCA case for further process at the earliest please.
