<u>Calculation of Penalty for Voilation of Forest</u> (Conservation) Act 1980

<u>**Proposal Details**</u> :- Diversion of 0.097035 ha. Forest land for approach road to "International City" developed by Competent Builders & Developers at Vill Nariyawal on Bareilly-Shahjahanpur Road Km Stone 244-245 NH-24 in District Bareilly.

Net Present Value (NPV) Calculation for Proposed Forest Land

Proposed Forest Land for Diversion (Eco Class-III and Forest Density is 0.2) = 0.097035 Ha.

Net Present Value (NPV) Rate = Rs. 626000.00 per hectare

Calculated NPV of Proposed Forest Land = Rs (0.097035 x 626000) = 60743.91

Or say = 60744.00

Since the proposer has violated the Forest Conservation Act 1980 before applying it, from 2016 to 2018. According Para 3B(i) Government of India letter No. 11-42 / 2017-FC date 29 01.2018, the penalty for violation shall be equal to NPV of forest land per hectare for each year of violation from the date of actual diversion as reported by the inspecting officer with maximum up to five (5) times of the NPV plus 12 percent simple interest till the deposit is made.

Thus the Penalty Amount =Rs. 60744.00 x 3

= Rs. 182232.00 + 12% Simple Interest till the date of deposition
