Justification for construction of PMGSY road from Melli Jorethang Road to Lower Ramabong, under Mellidara-Paiyong GPU, in South Sikkim. The sanctioned scheme requires forest clearance as it passes through Rolu Reserve Forest.

This project falls in the South district of Sikkim. This road will connect Lower Ramabong, Panchgharey village and Ramabong Primary School School to the Melli-Turuk PWD road which finally joins the Melli Town and the National Highway-10. The proposed road is 7.50 km in length. Presently there are no means of vehicular transportation facilities to this village to connect with the District HQ at Namchi and other important towns. The majority of the population are farmers and depend on agriculture. The road on completion will act as a lifeline of the people of the area for the transportation of their agricultural products to the town and help to transport their basic household amenities. It will also help them to reach the District offices, health care centers, etc. and have easier access to all facilities, which are not available in the village.
