2. The State Government of Punjab has appointed Punjab Heritage Tourism Promotion Board (PHTPB) as the implementing agency for execution of aforesaid work and payments will be released in favour of PHTPB in due course after approval of competent authority in accordance with para 6 hereinafter and submission of Nil Utilization Certificate Pending. PHTPB is also required to follow PFMS (Public Finance Monitoring System) in terms of the Ministry of Finance O.M. No.48(06)/PF-II/2016 dated 12.09.2017 for booking of expenditure for above project.
3. The State Govt. of Punjab shall make land for the project available free of cost and also render all possible assistance for completion of the project on time. No portion of the sanctioned project should be executed/implemented on land/property owned by private individual or trust.
4. The Secretary (Tourism), Govt. of Punjab will be the nodal officer for implementation and monitoring of the project. The State Government shall set up a Monitoring Committee headed by Secretary (Tourism) Punjab with a Member from the Ministry of Tourism and the Implementing agency to monitor physical and financial progress of the sanctioned project and submit the progress report to Ministry of Tourism on monthly basis.
5. The executing agency shall put in place the mandatory facilities for barrier free access by physically disabled persons.
6. PHTPB would execute the work and shall have the work started immediately to ensure timely utilization of funds and to avoid escalation of cost. The project should be completed and commissioned within 24 months and any cost escalation on account of delay etc. would be met by the PHTPB /Govt. of Punjab and no reimbursement will be made by the Central Government on this account. The first instalment being 30% of the project cost will be released to PHTPB on completion of tendering process and submission of work orders, Good for construction DPR with GFC statutory approvals from respective agencies for construction initiation and detailed BOQs. Second instalment being 30% of the project cost will be released after receipt of utilization certificate for the first instalment. Third instalment being 25% of the project cost will be released after receipt of utilization certificate for the second instalment and fourth instalment being 10% of the project cost on completion of the work and receipt of utilization certificate. Fifth and last instalment of 5% of the project cost will be released after successful O&M of Toilet, TFC, and Cafeteria facilities for one year as certified by an independent agency.

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7. The Central Financial Assistance will be utilized for the purpose for which funds are released. The State Government/executing agency shall not rent/lease or transfer the property without the permission of the Ministry of Tourism Government of India.
8. PHTPB /Govt. of Punjab would undertake the responsibility for maintenance and management of facilities for which the funds are released and no reimbursement on account of losses incurred, if any, would be made by the Central Government.
9. PHTPB shall follow PWD Schedule of rates and also follow all codal formalities while executing the project. The State Government/executing agency would take all necessary clearances which are required as per prevailing rules and regulations including relating to environment, forest & pollution control before undertaking this project.
10. The fourth and fifth installment will be released in the form of reimbursement on receipt of Utilization Certificate for the total amount of Central financial assistance sanctioned for the project, details of contribution made by the State Government/executing agency towards State component, Completion/Commissioning Certificate to the effect that the project has been completed as per the original plan, drawing, blue print etc., approved by the Central Government and the State Government/executing agency has followed all the codal formalities while executing the project, Management Agreement for proper upkeep, maintenance and operation of the asset created and Undertaking that the facility and the land on which the project has been constructed out of Central financial assistance will not be transferred/sold/alienated without the approval of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.
11. PHTPB /Govt. of Punjab shall regularly furnish the monthly statement of progress of work and expenditure incurred to the Central Govt., Ministry of Tourism.
12. Commercial Quotes etc. furnished along with the project proposal should not be deemed as accepted by Government of India. The Executing Agency/State Government shall follow the codal procedures of inviting tenders etc. while actually awarding the work for execution.
13. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of CFA except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned in accordance with the procedure laid down in GFR shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the authority which sanctioned the Central Financial Assistance.
14. The State Government/executing agency will maintain subsidiary account of the Government grant and furnish to the Accounts Officer a set of audited statement of accounts. These audited statement of accounts are required to be furnished after utilization of the grants-in-aid or whenever called for.

The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning Authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department.

16. The issues with the concurrence of the Integrated Finance vide their U.O. No.697 dated 17.07.2018,
