In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009, wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued, it is certified that 0.0295 (295 Sq.m) Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, RWS Division, No.141/1, Lake Avenue, Ind Street, Melamaiyur, Chengalpattu-603002 that for laying 600mm diameter DI pipe adjacent to forest land in highways Right of Way (ROW) in Vandalur to Walajabad road at KM 44/905 to 45/200 for an area of 295 Sq.m or 0.0295 Hec. Land Which is available in Vattambakkam Reserved Forest of Sriperumbudur Range in Chengalpattu Forest Division falls within jurisdiction of Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kanchipuram District.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The Complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire area of 0.0295 Hectares of forest land proposed for diversion.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Police Department have consent to it.
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities.
